



## IN THE EVENT OF A POST EMERGENCY

In order to refine District Safety Procedures, it is the District's responsibility to inform parents/guardians and staff members of steps that will be taken during a declaration of a Force Protection Condition or any Post Emergency.

*In the unlikely event a Post or School emergency is declared, our facility shall consider safety first, and therefore will make announcements on radio stations, the district website, and make phone calls to parents.*

- **Local Radio Stations:** KTAN 1420 AM, KZMK 100.9 FM & KKYZ 101.7 FM and Cable Television Channel 97 (Commander's Access Channel)
- **District Website** informational updates [www.fthuachuca.k12.az.us](http://www.fthuachuca.k12.az.us)
- **Phone Calls to Parents** to inform them of the steps the School District has been instructed to take by the Post Command

**Parents/Guardians:** if you have a change of address or phone number, it is VITAL for you to contact your child's school office immediately to update this information.

**Staff Members:** please notify the district office and your employment site (in writing) of any new/additional phone numbers, addresses, or any other contact information for emergency purposes.

There are **Five** Force Protection Conditions that can be declared: **Normal, Alpha, Bravo, Charlie** and **Delta**. Occasionally, the Post conducts Force Protection Exercises. In the past, **The Fort Huachuca Scout** has informed the public on the nature of the exercise, and has fully explained what to expect.

### **THERE ARE 5 FPCONS (Force Protection Conditions):**

**FPCON NORMAL** applies when a general global threat of possible terrorist activity exists and warrants a **routine** security posture.

**FPCON ALPHA** applies when there is an **increased general threat** of possible terrorist activity against personnel or facilities, the nature and extent are unpredictable. ALPHA measures must be capable of being maintained indefinitely.

**FPCON BRAVO** applies when an **increased or more predictable** threat of terrorist activity exists. Sustaining BRAVO measures for a prolonged period may affect operational capability and relations with local authorities.

**FPCON CHARLIE** applies **when an incident occurs or intelligence is received** indicating some form of terrorist action or targeting against personnel or facilities is likely. Prolonged implementation of CHARLIE measures may create hardship and affect the activities of the unit and its personnel.

**FPCON DELTA** applies in the immediate area **where a terrorist attack has occurred or when intelligence has been received** that terrorist action against a specific location or person is imminent. Normally, this FPCON is declared as a localized condition. FPCON DELTA measures are not intended to be sustained for substantial periods.
